- Interest in cities, sustainable transportation, urban planning, or related areas
- Good communicator with good written, oral and interpersonal communication skills
- Capable of conducting fast-paced internet research
- Strong attention to detail and problem solving skills
- Ability to manage time efficiently, especially to discern and prioritize urgent requests
