Organization

The Institute for Transportation and Development Policy (ITDP) works with cities around the world to promote sustainable and equitable transport and urban development. ITDP is a nonprofit organization headquartered in New York City with offices in China, India, Indonesia, Brazil, Argentina, Mexico and the United States. Position

The goal of the Policy Program globally is to leverage sustainable transportation as a principal driver for sustainable and livable urban development. The program advocates and catalyzes sustainable urban development in Brazilian cities, building on the National Law on Urban Mobility. We work with government officials and society, using technical knowledge accumulated through experience in other countries, to inspire excellence in the implementation of Municipal Mobility Plans, best practice solutions and promote their potential for replication.

The Policy Program Manager will be responsible for shaping and implementing a program to catalyze policy reform, facilitating better integration of land use policies with public transport systems. The Policy Program Manager will be based in Rio de Janeiro, with focus on working with the Ministry of Cities, in Brasília, and work at the municipal level with all of ITDP Brazil's targeted cities. This position reports to the Country Director.

Responsibilities

- Support projects relevant to national and municipal policies including:
 - Conduct technical assessments
 - Coordinate capacity building activities
 - Prepare case studies to share best practice with local and international counterparts
 - Coordinate events and campaign
 - Coordinate workplans for international and local consultants in Brazil, and participate in the execution of these activities, together with consultants and partners.
- Support the Country Director in maintaining working relationships with national and local government officials, the private sector and other NGO partners.
- Represent ITDP Brazil in meetings with civil society and governmental partners.
- Report on project progress on a weekly basis.
- Assist in fundraising and preparing reports to funders.
- Collaborate with ITDP staff, worldwide, to create content for ITDP events and communications material.
- Collaborate with ITDP staff to achieve communications deliverables

Key qualifications

- Bachelors Degree in Economics, Engineering, Geography, Architecture or related field. Masters preferred.
- Minimum of 5 years of experience in subject areas pertinent to the job description.
- Knowledge of alternative modes of transportation, transportation policy and urban mobility.
- Ability to conduct survey and case study research, including assembling and organizing data and preparing standard reports.

Key attributes

- Excellent writing and verbal communication skills in English and Portuguese.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective partners in the government and civil society.
- Ability to work effectively and prioritize work according to local strategy.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team in a fast paced environment.
- Ability to work in a multicultural and geographically distributed team.
- Ability to work on multiple projects and short-term deadlines.
- Available to travel throughout Brazil and, on occasion, internationally.
